	 ROME — The anthropological vision of John Paul II on love, life and human sexuality, developed in his "theology of the body" (TOB) catechesis, has become a polestar for a whole generation. Gathering a series of 129 catechetical addresses pronounced during his Wednesday audiences in St. Peter Square from Sept. 5, 1979, to Nov. 28, 1984, the theology of the body remains a key element of John Paul's thought and a major papal contribution to the Church's teaching on human sexuality Although the Pope's addresses remained relatively unknown until the 1990s, this crucial work is now widespread — and continues to spread — thanks to the commitment of individuals around the world who have dedicated their lives to teaching John Paul's vision, notably through the organization of large conferences and the creation of institutes and associations. How does the film jive with a Judaeo-Christian, biblical, sacramental, Theology of the Body worldview? SHOULD I WATCH THIS FILM (AS AN ADULT)? Pray. Pray before, during, after the film. Know thyself. Hit pause. It's OK to look away / fast forward / turn off / walk away / walk out / take a stand. Ask yourself: Why am I watching this film in the first place? We are always disciples of Jesus Christ and must always glorify Him in all that we do, including our media/digital lives. Will watching this film glorify Him? (Even if it might be objectionable in parts, am I watching it to study it and help myself and others? Never use "I'm studying it" as an excuse!) Be brutally honest about how this film is affecting you, body and soul. How it's affecting your relationship with God, self, family,

1. It is becoming increasingly clear that we are now facing with what might accurately be called an educational crisis, especially in the field of affectivity and sexuality. In many places, curricula are being planned and implemented which "allegedly convey a neutral conception of the person and of life, yet in fact reflect an anthropology opposed to faith and to right reason".¹ The disorientation regarding anthropology which is a widespread feature of our cultural landscape has undoubtedly helped to destabilise the family as an institution, bringing with it a tendency to cancel out the differences between men and women, presenting them instead as merely the product of historical and cultural conditioning.

Teen girls on the pill may have long-term risk to bones

A growing number of teenage girls in Canada use oral and other forms of hormonal contraceptives. Doctors prescribe them for birth control and other reasons. A review published in January in the journal Clinical Endocrinology has identified a serious long-term risk: a strong link between the use of combined estrogen and progesterone and loss of bone mineral density.

Researchers at the Centre for Menstrual Cycle and Ovulation Research at the University of British Columbia looked at published studies that compared women age 12 to 19 who used combined hormone contraceptives and compared them to adolescents who did not take hormone treatment. They compared how much accrual of bone mineral density took place during a 12 to 24 month period. A total of 1,535 adolescents were compared over a 12month period and 885 adolescents over a 24-month period.

Throughout both time intervals, teenage girls on hormone treatment had statistically and clinically significantly lower bone mineral density than those not on treatment.
